

Senior Citizen Guest Policies

Please Note:

- Senior Citizen Guests must be 62 years of age or older to be a guest in a course at no charge.
- Senior Citizen Guests may be a guest in only one (1) course per term.
- Senior Citizen Guests sit in on the traditional lecture courses. Participation is not permitted in laboratories or other non lecture course components.
- Tuition paying students receive first priority. Classes with full enrollment or individualized instruction classes are not available for Senior Citizen Guests
- Do not submit this form to the faculty member teaching the course until after the first day of classes.
- Books - The purchase of any books is the responsibility of the Senior Citizen Guest. The University Bookstore is located in McIntosh Center, (419) 227-2410.
- When this form is completed and signed by the faculty member teaching the class, return the form to the Registrar's Office for processing, and notification of the faculty member.
